Second Harvest Food Bank of Orange County is the leading hunger-relief organization in Orange County. Currently there are 315,000 food insecure individuals within Orange County and one-third of our residents are considered financially unstable. Each month, we feed more than 250,000 individuals but this leaves 65,000 families, children and seniors without support.

We have launched our new five-year Strategic Plan which includes a **Bold Goal** to make a greater impact in the community by providing more high-quality, nutritious food to children, families and seniors who continue to need our help. Our **Bold Goal** will increase the number of meals we provide from 20 million to 30 million by 2021 and will help us potentially close the entire meal gap by 2025. It is our mission to end hunger in Orange County and provide families with hope for a future with big dreams and Bold Goals.

Our founder, Daniel J. Harney, was a pioneer for change and left a legacy of hunger relief in Orange County. In 1978, Harney established Society of St. Vincent de Paul, what later became known as Second Harvest Food Bank, through stewarding the community around him to help create a positive impact. To keep his generous spirit alive, Second Harvest has established the *Daniel J. Harney Legacy Society*.

The **Daniel J. Harney Legacy Society** is designed to recognize and honor those who have decided to be bold and leave a legacy of hunger relief by making provisions for a future gift through a bequest, life insurance, annuity, trust agreement or an outright gift to our endowment fund. Each member of the *Daniel J.
