- Provide the equivalent of **3,075,690 meals** to Orange County residents at risk of going hungry
- Distribute more than **4 million pounds** of fresh produce through 45 Mobile Pantries
- Distribute the equivalent of more than **1 million meals** to vulnerable seniors through our Senior Grocery Program
- Provide the infrastructure funding to add **two Permanent School Pantries** – Mercado El Sol and La Colonia, which serve more than 1,200 families each week
- Spend more than **90 cents of every dollar** on programs to feed the hungry

FROM OUR HEART TO YOURS

Dear Friends,

We are excited to report our accomplishments as we approach the end of the second year of our Bold Goal plan to feed all who are hungry in our community. We are pleased to share our progress – and to look ahead at what it will take to build a hunger-free community.

Over the past 25 years, Harvesters have raised enough money to provide the equivalent of more than 30 million meals to the hungry, and last year's luncheon alone provided the equivalent of over 3 million nutritious meals.

Most of those we feed are the working poor who struggle to be able to pay for basic necessities like food, medicine and housing. So many of the hungry are children, seniors and people with disabilities who must depend on others for sustenance. Without food from Second Harvest, children can't pay attention and learn in school, seniors are at risk of losing their ability to live independently, and people with disabilities would have nowhere to turn for the food they need. The nutritious food you help us provide is a crucial lifeline for them and their families.

As we continue to grow our programs and our distribution, our community partners have also forged ahead with their capacity-building measures allowing us to increase the number of meals and to reach more of the hungry. In the past year Second Harvest has made good progress towards closing the meal gap in Orange County, increasing the number of people we're able to serve from 200,000 to 250,000 each month.

With your continued support, now going on its 26th year, we have been able to achieve our goals for this past year and we are confident that next year we will show even more progress towards our Bold Goal of ending hunger in Orange County by 2025.

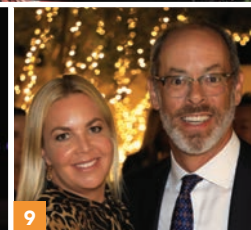
STRENGTHENING PARTNERS
